ACOOGO	Acorus gramineus 'Ogon'	Semi-evergreen, perennial, Fan of narrow, stiff, grass like leaves are green with cream variegation. Height 25cm. Spread 15cm. Requires full sun. Prefers moist conditions, ideal for bog garden or pool margin.	2 lit.
ACOVAR	Acorus gramineus 'Variegatus'	Semi-evergreen, perennial, Narrow, stiff, grass like leaves are dark green with cream variegation. Height 25cm. Spread 15cm. Requires full sun. Prefers moist conditions, ideal for bog garden or pool margin.	2 lit.
AGRCSN	Agrostis canina 'Silver Needles'	"Velvet Bent Grass" Tufts of fine very small green leaves edged with silver-white. Height 25cm. Slowly spreading habit. Prefers well drained in full sun or partial shade.	2 lit.
ALOPAU	Alopecurus pratensis 'Aureus'	"Golden Meadow Foxtail" Densely tufted, perennial grass with almost entirely golden leaves and dense flower spikes in April-May. Height 25cm. Best in sun or partial shade.	2 lit.
AMPMAU	Ampelodesmos mauritanica	"Mauritania Vine Reed" Forms large clumps of evergreen leaves which produce large, one sided panicles borne on pendulous branches from spring through to mid-winter. Unusual and interesting specimen plant. Height 300cm Spread 180cm. Best in sunny well drained position.	2 lit.
ANDGER	Andropogon gerardii	"Big Bluestem" Densely tufted perennial grass with blue green leaves, which turn purple in autumn. Deep red-purple flower heads September to October. Height 200cm. Prefers well drained sandy soil and full sun. Cut back in spring before new growth appears.	2 lit.
ARREVAR	Arrhenatherum elatius 'Variegatum'	"False Oat Grass" A loosely tufted grass with basal stem swelling, herbaceous. Striking leaves striped and edged pure white. Oat-like brown panicles in summer. Height 50cm. Sun or partial shade.	2 lit.
ARUDVER	Arundo donax var. versicolor (syn. 'Variegata')	"Giant Reed" Herbaceous, rhizomatous, perennial grass with strong stems bearing broad, creamy- white striped leaves. May bear dense, erect panicles of whitish-yellow spikelets in late summer. Height 2.5-3m. Spread 60cm. Requires full sun and moist soil.	5 lit.
BOUGRA	Bouteloua gracilis	"Mosquito Grass" Semi-evergreen, tuft forming, narrow leaved, perennial grass. In summer bears comb-like spikes, 4cm long, held at right angles to stems. Height 50cm. Spread 20cm. Requires full sun and well drained soil.	2 lit.
BRIMED	Briza media	"Quaking Grass" Attractive heart shaded spikelets that make a gentle rustling sound in breeze. Flowers May to August. Height 50cm. Suitable for dried arrangements. Planting in full sun.	2 lit.
CALBRA	Calamagrostis brachytricha	"Diamond Grass" Densely tufted perennial grass, Purplish flowers in late summer and Autumn. Height 120cm. Best in full sun and well drained soil. RHS 'Award of Garden Merit'	2 lit.
CALKF	Calamagrostis x acutiflora 'Karl Foerster'	"Feather Reed Grass" Showy brown flower head from June lasting into the Winter. Height 150cm - 200cm. Prefers damp site.	2 lit.
CALOVE	Calamagrostis x actiuflora 'Overdam'	"Feather Reed Grass" Mound forming grass with arching leaves striped white narrow upright habit. Attractive flowers in summer. Height 100 cm. Prefers damp site.	2 lit.
CARAUR	Carex elata 'Aurea'	"Bowles's Golden Sedge" Evergreen, tuft forming, perennial sedge with golden yellow leaves. Solid, triangular stems bear blackish-brown flower spikes in summer. Height to 40cm. Spread 15cm. Requires full sun and wet soil. RHS 'Award of Garden Merit'.	2 lit.
CARBUC	Carex buchananii	"Leatherleaf Sedge" One of the most colourful sedges with upright reddish-brown foliage. Forms dense tufts, flowers produced June to August. Prefers damp to wet soil. RHS 'Award of Garden Merit',	2 lit.
CARBVAR	Carex brunnea 'Variegata'	Densely tufted sedge with dark green leaves margined with a yellow band. Brown flowers in May to June. Height 45 cm. Best grown in a damp to wet soil in a sheltered position. Protect in severe winters. Can be grown as a house plant.	2 lit.

CARBZ	Carex flacca 'Blue Zinger'	Evergreen loosely tufted sedge, with creeping rhizomes. Light blue-green leaves. Height 25cm. Ideal for ground cover. Will grow in both moist and dry conditions.	2 lit.
CARCBF	Carex comans 'Bronze Form'	"New Zealand Hairy Sedge" Very densely tufted sedge from New Zealand. Unusual dull brown hair-like leaves. Flowers June-August. Height 45 cm. Best grown in a damp to wet soil in a sheltered position.	2 lit.
CAREG	Carex oshimensis 'Evergold'	An attractive sedge forming compact tufts with arching leaves with broad creamy yellow stripe. Height 30 cm. Best grown in a damp to wet soil in a sheltered position. RHS 'Award of Garden Merit'.	2 lit.
CARFC	Carex comans 'Frosted Curls'	New from New Zealand. Forms a compact silver-green "haystack" with brown seed heads. Height 20cm. Requires sun or light shade and moist acid soil.	2 lit.
CARFLAG	Carex flagellifera	New Zealand sedge with upright long stems and coarse leaves of pale bronze to tawny brown. Forms low arching dome of dense tufts. Height 50-70cm. Prefers damp to wet soil.	2 lit.
CARIB	Carex 'Island Brocade'	Variegated sedge from Japan. Vigorous habit with strong golden edges. Ideal for containers. Height 20cm. Best grown in a damp to wet soil in full sun or partial shade.	2 lit.
CARID	Carex 'Ice Dance'	An attractive sedge forming tufts with arching white variegated leaves. Produces slowly spreading runners. Height 40 cm. Best grown in a damp to wet soil in full sun or partial shade.	2 lit.
CARIF	Carex 'Ice Fountains'	An attractive variegated sedge forming tufts with upright white leaves with dark green edges, the fade to light green by mid-summer. Height 60 cm. Best grown in a damp to wet soil in full sun or partial shade. Plant breeders rights. (Propagation Prohibited)	2 lit.
CARKAG	Carex dolichostachya 'Kaga-nishiki'	An attractive sedge forming compact tufts with arching leaves. Pale green leaves that are variegated golden yellow. Height 25cm. Best grown in a damp to wet soil.	2 lit.
CARMFF	Carex morrowii 'Fishers Form'	An attractive sedge forming compact tufts with arching leaves. Large cream variegated leaves. Height 50 cm. Best grown in a damp to wet soil in a sheltered position.	2 lit.
CARMLM	Carex muskingumensis 'Little Midge'	'Dwarf Palm Sedge' Evergreen, tuft-forming graceful perennial sedge with narrow green leaves. Brown flowers in summer. Height 25cm. Spread 20cm. Best plants in groups. Prefers damp site. Will grow in full sun or light shade.	2 lit.
CARMOO	Carex pendula 'Moonraker'	Evergreen, tuft-forming graceful perennial sedge with pale, creamy white spring foliage, greenish brown flower spikes in summer. Height 120cm. Spread 50cm. Requires partial shade and moist soil.	2 lit.
CARMUS	Carex muskingumensis	"Palm Sedge" Evergreen, tuft-forming graceful perennial sedge with narrow green leaves. Attractive flowers in summer. Prefers damp site. Height 50 - 60cm	2 lit.
CAROVAR	Carex ornithopoda 'Variegata'	"Bird's Foot Sedge" Densely tufted, leaves narrowly striped white. Height 20cm. Prefers moist soil.	2 lit.
CARPEN	Carex pendula	"Weeping Sedge" Evergreen, tuft-forming graceful perennial sedge with narrow green leaves, 45cm long. Solid, triangular stems freely produce pendant, greenish brown flower spikes in summer. Height 1m. Spread 30cm. Requires partial shade and well drained soil.	2 lit.
CARPLA	Carex plantaginea	"Plantain-leafed Sedge" An attractive sedge forming compact tufts with arching leaves. Broad soft green leaves tinted red at the base. Height 30 cm. Best grown in a damp to wet soil in a sheltered position.	2 lit.

		Unusual form of <i>Carex morrowii</i> . An evergreen sedge forming clumps of fine wispy white and dark green leaves, Height 25 cm. Best grown in a damp in a sheltered position.	
CARTEN	Carex tenuiculmis		2 lit.
		Upright clump forming sedge from New Zealand. Arching light brown leaves. Flower spikes in May. Height up to 45cm. Best grown in sunny position.	
CARTES	Carex testacea		2 lit.
		"Orange New Zealand Sedge" Clump forming sedge from New Zealand. Arching pale olive leaves turning orange when grown in full sun . Black flower spikes. Height up to 45cm. Best grown in sunny position.	
CHALAT	Chasmanthium latiflora (Syn. Uniola latifolium)		2 lit.
		"American Wild Oats" Large green flat spikelets which hang gracefully from drooping panicles. Best in semi-shade and moist soil. Suitable cutting and drying. 80cm.	
CHICON	Chionochloa conspicua		2 lit.
		'Plumed Tussock Grass' from New Zealand. Tussock forming grass with huge, feathery flower-heads, resembling pampas grass in summer. Broad tawny-green foliage, Best grown in a sheltered, well-drained position and full sun. Height 200cm Spread 100cm. Good for cut or dried flowers.	
CHIRUB	Chionochloa rubra		2 lit.
		Dense, tussock forming grass from New Zealand with narrow dull reddish-brown leaves. Small panicles in July to August. Height 45cm. Best grow in a sunny sheltered position.	
CORPUM	Cortaderia selloana 'Pumila'		3 lit.
		"Pampas Grass" Evergreen, clump forming, stately perennial grass. Frost hardy. Has narrow very sharp edged outward curving leaves 1.6m long. In late summer, erect plume like silvery panicles up to 60cm long are borne above mid green leaves. RHS 'Award of Garden Merit'	
CORRIC	Cortaderia richardii		3 lit.
		"Pampas Grass" Evergreen, clump forming stately perennial grass. Frost hardy. Has narrow very sharp edged outward curving leaves. In late summer, erect plume like silvery panicles up to 200cm long are borne above mid green leaves. Prefers full sun.	
CORWF	Cortaderia selloana 'White Feather'		3 lit.
		"Pampas Grass" Tussock forming grass with spectacular tall silver-white plumes. Ideal specimen plant. Height 180cm. Requires full sun and well drained soil.	
DESCBH	Deschampsia cespitosa 'Goldgehänge' (Golden Pendant)		2 lit.
		Arching tussocks of shining dark green leaves. Large panicles tinted gold produced from June to August, that last into the winter. Height 45 cm. Grows best in moist semi-shade ideal in woodland setting.	
DESCBV	Deschampsia c. 'Bronze Veil' ('Bronzeschleier')		2 lit.
		"Tufted Hair Grass" Arching tussocks of shining dark green leaves. Large panicles tinted bronze produced from June to August, that last into the winter. Height 100 cm. Grows best in moist semi-shade ideal in woodland setting.	
DESCES	Deschampsia cespitosa		2 lit.
		"Tufted Hairy Grass" Attractive 'mop head' clumps of shining dark. Large, fine hair-like panicles from June to August, that last into the winter. Height 90 cm. Grows best in moist semi-shade ideal in woodland setting.

DESNL	Deschampsia c. 'Northern Lights'	"Tufted Hair Grass" Compact tussocks green and white variegated leaves. Graceful panicles turning golden yellow in Autumn. Height 80 cm. Grows best in moist soil in full sun.	2 lit.
ELYMAG	Elymus magellanicus (syn. Agropyron magellanicus)	"Magellan Wheatgrass" One of the best blue grasses. Metallic chalky blue leaves with soft spears. Forms non-invasive clumps. Height 45 cm. Prefers a sunny position.	2 lit.
ERAELL	Eragrostis eliottii	'Blue Love Grass' Clump forming perennial grass. Blue-green nodding flowers in summer. Height 70cm. Best grown in full sun.	2 lit.
ERASPE	Eragrostis spectabilis	'Purple Love Grass' Perennial grass forming dense clumps of light green leaves that turn red in the autumn. Brilliant purple-red flower plumes in late summer. Height 50cm.	2 lit.
FESAME	Festuca amethystina	"Large Blue Fescue" Evergreen, tuft forming. Fully hardy. Has soft narrow blue-grey leaves. Bears panicles of spikelets in summer. Divide every 2-3 years in spring. Height 50cm. Best in sunny position.	2 lit.
FESGBF	Festuca glauca 'Blue Fox' ('Blaufuchs')	Evergreen, tuft forming perennial grass. Fully hardy. Has narrow grey-blue leaves. Bears panicles of spikelets in summer. Divide every 2-3 years in spring. Height 15cm. Requires sun. RHS 'Award of Garden Merit'	2 lit.
FESGEB	Festuca glauca 'Elijah Blue'	Evergreen, tuft forming. Fully hardy. Has narrow blue-grey leaves. Bears panicles of spikelets in summer. Divide every 2-3 years in spring. Height 15cm. Requires sun or light shade. Best planted in groups.	2 lit.
FESGGT	Festuca glauca 'Golden Toupee'	Evergreen, tuft forming. Fully hardy. Has narrow golden yellow leaves. Bears panicles of spikelets in summer. Divide every 2-3 years in spring. Height 25cm. Requires sun or light shade. Best planted in groups.	2 lit.
FESGLA	Festuca glauca	"Blue Fescue" Evergreen, tuft forming. Fully hardy. Has narrow leaves in various shades of blue-green to silvery white. Bears panicles of spikelets in summer. Divide every 2-3 years in spring. Height 10cm. Requires sun.	2 lit.
FESGMIN	Festuca glauca minima	A very dwarf form of Festuca glauca, evergreen, with fine blue-grey leaves, neat habit. Height 10 cm. Prefers full sun.	2 lit.
FESSIL	Festuca glauca 'Silberreiher'	Evergreen, tuft forming. Fully hardy. Has narrow silvery-blue leaves. Bears panicles of spikelets in summer. Divide every 2-3 years in spring. Height 15cm. Best grown in full sun and well drained soil.	2 lit.
FESVGLA	Festuca valesiaca var. glaucantha	"Wallis Fescue" Evergreen, tuft forming. Fully hardy. Has fine blue-green hair-like leaves. Bears panicles of spikelets in May to June. Divide every 2-3 years in spring. Height 25cm. Requires sun.	2 lit.
GLYMVAR	Glyceria maxima 'Variegata'	Herbaceous, spreading, perennial grass with cream striped leaves, often tinged pink at the base. Bears open panicles of greenish spikelets in summer. Height 80cm. Spread indefinite. Requires full sun and moist soil.	2 lit.
HAKMAC	Hakonechloa macra	"Hakone Grass" Slow growing, rhizomatous grass, with yellow leaves that age to reddish brown. Open panicles of reddish brown flower spikes may appear in autumn and last into winter. Height 35cm. Requires full sun and well drained soil.	2 lit.

HELSEM	Helictotrichon sempervirens (syn. Avena candida)	"Blue Oat-grass" Evergreen, tufted, perennial grass with stiff silvery-blue leaves up to 30cm or more long. Produces erect panicles of straw coloured flower spikes in summer. Height 1 metre. Spread 60 cm. Requires full sun and well drained soil. RHS 'Award of Garden Merit'.	2 lit.
HOLMALB	Holcus mollis 'Albovariegatus'	"Creeping Softgrass" Evergreen, spreading, perennial grass with white striped leaves and hairy nodes. In summer carries purplish-white flower spikes. Clip back after flowering. Height 30-45cm. Spread indefinite. Sun or partial shade and well drained soil.	2 lit.
IMPRB	Imperata cylindrica 'Rubra'	"Blood Grass". Long narrow reddish foliage turning bright crimson through Summer with contrasting silvery-white flowers. Height 60cm Spread 30cm. Plant in sun or light shade in moist soil.	2 lit.
JUNAFR	Juncus inflexus 'Afro'	Clumps of thick spiralled dark green leaves. Suitable for flower arrangements. Prefers moist situation. Height 35cm	2 lit.
JUNCG	Juncus patens 'Carmen's Grey'	Green grey evergreen upright foliage, clump forming habit, small brown flowers, height 50cm. Prefers moist position.	2 lit.
JUNEB	Juncus 'Elks Blue'	Blue-grey evergreen upright foliage, clump forming habit, small brown flowers, height 60cm. Prefers moist position.	2 lit.
JUNSPI	Juncus filiformis 'Spiralis'	Evergreen, tuft forming, perennial rush with dark green leafless stems that twist and curl and are often prostrate. Fairly dense, greenish-brown flower panicles form in summer. Height 20 cm. Requires full sun and moist soil.	2 lit.
KOEGLA	Koeleria glauca	"Blue Hair Grass". Dense clumps of narrow blue leaves. Height 25cm. Best in a sunny situation.	2 lit.
LEYARE	Leymus arenarius (syn. Elymus arenarius)	"Blue Lyme Grass" Tuft forming grasses with distinctive blue-grey foliage. Upright habit, slowly spreading. Buff blue flowers from June to August. Height 60cm. Sunny position.	2 lit.
LUZAUR	Luzula sylvatica 'Aurea'	Evergreen, slow-spreading, perennial rush with fairly dense clusters of chestnut flower spikes in early summer. Leaves are yellow and lined with white hairs. Height 45cm, spread 30cm. Requires partial shade and well drained soil.	2 lit.
LUZHT	Luzula sylvatica 'Hohe Tatra'	"Greater Wood-rush" Evergreen, slow-spreading, perennial rush with fairly dense clusters of brown flower spikes in early summer. Leaves are yellow - green and lined with white hairs. Height 30cm, spread 30 cm. Requires partial shade and well drained soil.	2 lit.
LUZIGE	Luzula pilosa 'Igel' ('Hedgehog')	Perennial woodrush forming compact, low mounds of dark green, glossy leaves. Evergreen. Suitable for pots. Height 15cm. Makes good groundcover, best grow in sun or part shade, on most soils, moist or moderately dry.	2 lit.
LUZNIV	Luzula nivea	"Snowy Wood-rush" Evergreen, slow-spreading, perennial rush with fairly dense clusters of shining, white flower spikes in early summer. Leaves are edged with white hairs. Height 60cm. Requires partial shade.	2 lit.

		"Siberian Melic" Loosely tufted perennial grass. Deep mauve flowers hanging 45° from the stem May to June. Sun or part shade. Will tolerate dry soil. 100cm.

		"Hairy Melic" Evergreen, tuft forming, perennial grass. Fluffy off-white flower heads produce from June to August. Height 45 cm. Requires full sun, suitable for a dry site.	
MELUVAR	Melica uniflora 'Variegata'		2 lit.
		"Wood Melic". Loosely tufted perennial grass with striped green and white leaves. Flower heads produced from May to June. Height 50 cm. Requires shade and good soil.	
MILAU	Millium effusum 'Aureum'		2 lit.
		"Bowles's Golden Grass" Erect tufts of bright lemon yellow leaves. Ideal for lighting up shaded areas. Light airy flower heads. 40cm. Prefers moist semi-shade. RHS 'Award of Garden Merit'.	
MISCHI	Miscanthus sinensis 'China'		3 lit.
		Herbaceous, clump forming, perennial grass, with narrow leaves, hairy beneath often turning bronze. May bear fan shaped panicles of awned, deep red spikelets in early autumn. Height 90cm. Spread 45cm. Requires full sun and well drained soil.	
MISCOS	Miscanthus sinensis var. condensatus 'Cosmopolitan'		3 lit.
		Herbaceous, perennial grass, forming dense clumps with distinctive golden variegated leaves, feathery spikelets in late summer. Height 300cm. Requires full sun and well drained soil. RHS 'Award of Garden Merit'	
MISFLA	Miscanthus sinensis 'Flamingo'		2 lit.
		Herbaceous, clump forming, perennial grass, feathery pinkish-red spikelets in August to October. Height 150cm. Requires full sun and well drained soil. RHS 'Award of Garden Merit'	
MISFO	Miscanthus sinensis 'Ferne Osten'		2 lit.
		Herbaceous, clump forming, perennial grass with compact habit. Narrow leaves with silver midrib. Reddish flowers in autumn. Height 120cm. Spread 45cm. Requires full sun and well drained soil.	
MISGB	Miscanthus sinensis 'Gold Bar'		2 lit.
		Herbaceous, clump-forming, perennial grass. Compact, upright habit. Leaves have transverse, cream-yellow markings. Carries white flower heads in autumn, that last overwinter. Height 60cm. Requires full sun and well drained soil. Plant Breeder Rights Apply, (Propagation prohibited).

		Herbaceous, clump forming, perennial grass, with narrow leaves. Silver inflorescence during July and August which retain interest during Winter. Height 180cm. Requires full sun and well drained soil. RHS 'Award of Garden Merit'	
MISGIF	Miscanthus sinensis 'Giraffe'		3 lit.
		Herbaceous, clump-forming, perennial grass. Fine gold banded leaves, hairy spikelets in fan-shaped panicles in autumn. Height 200cm. Spread 45cm. Requires full sun and well drained soil.	
MISGIG	Miscanthus x giganteus		3 lit.
