ACOOGO	<b>Acorus gramineus 'Ogon'</b>	Semi-evergreen, perennial, Fan of narrow, stiff, grass like leaves are green with cream variegation. Height 25cm. Spread 15cm. Requires full sun. Prefers moist conditions, ideal for bog garden or pool margin.	2 lit.
ACOPUS	<b>Acorus gramineus var. pusillus</b>	Semi-evergreen, fan of narrow, stiff, olive green grass like leaves. Height 8cm. Spread 15cm. Requires full sun. Prefers moist conditions, ideal for bog garden or pool margin.	2 lit.
ACOVAR	<b>Acorus gramineus 'Variegatus'</b>	Semi-evergreen, perennial, Narrow, stiff, grass like leaves are dark green with cream variegation. Height 25cm. Spread 15cm. Requires full sun. Prefers moist conditions, ideal for bog garden or pool margin.	2 lit.
ALOPAU	<b>Alopecurus pratensis 'Aureus'</b>	"Golden Meadow Foxtail" Densely tufted, perennial grass with almost entirely golden leaves and dense flower spikes in April-May. Height 25cm. Best in sun or partial shade.	2 lit.
AMPAU	<b>Ampelodesmos mauritanica</b>	"Mauritania Vine Reed" Forms large clumps of evergreen leaves which produce large, one sided panicles borne on pendulous branches from spring through to mid-winter. Unusual and interesting specimen plant. Height 300cm Spread 180cm. Best in sunny well drained position.	2 lit.
ANELES	<b>Anemanthele lessoniana (syn. Stipa arundinacea)</b>	syn. Stipa arundinacea "Pheasant's Tail Grass" Attractive tufted hardy perennial grass with arching culms, and flowers from July to September. Leaves gradually become streaked with orange and bright brown as summer advances. Retains an orangey-brown colour throughout Winter. Height 150 cm. Prefers full sun and will tolerate a dry position. RHS 'Award of Garden Merit'	2 lit.
BOUGRA	<b>Bouteloua gracilis</b>	"Mosquito Grass" Semi-evergreen, tuft forming, narrow leaved, perennial grass. In summer bears comb-like spikes, 4cm long, held at right angles to stems. Height 50cm. Spread 20cm. Requires full sun and well drained soil.	2 lit.
BRIMED	<b>Briza media</b>	"Quaking Grass" Attractive heart shaded spikelets that make a gentle rustling sound in breeze. Flowers May to August. Height 50cm. Suitable for dried arrangements. Planting in full sun.	2 lit.
CALBRA	<b>Calamagrostis brachytricha</b>	"Diamond Grass" Densely tufted perennial grass, Purplish flowers in late summer and Autumn. Height 120cm. Best in full sun and well drained soil. RHS 'Award of Garden Merit'	2 lit.
CALKF	<b>Calamagrostis x acutiflora 'Karl Foerster'</b>	"Feather Reed Grass" Showy brown flower head from June lasting into the Winter. Height 150cm - 200cm. Prefers damp site.	2 lit.
CALOVE	<b>Calamagrostis x actiuiflora 'Overdam'</b>	"Feather Reed Grass" Mound forming grass with arching leaves striped white narrow upright habit. Attractive flowers in summer. Height 100 cm. Prefers damp site.	2 lit.
CARAUR	<b>Carex elata 'Aurea'</b>	"Bowles's Golden Sedge" Evergreen, tuft forming, perennial sedge with golden yellow leaves. Solid, triangular stems bear blackish-brown flower spikes in summer. Height to 40cm. Spread 15cm. Requires full sun and wet soil. RHS 'Award of Garden Merit'.	2 lit.
CARBUC	<b>Carex buchananii</b>	"Leatherleaf Sedge" One of the most colourful sedges with upright reddish-brown foliage. Forms dense tufts, flowers produced June to August. Prefers damp to wet soil. RHS 'Award of Garden Merit',	2 lit.
CARCBF	<b>Carex comans 'Bronze Form'</b>	"New Zealand Hairy Sedge" Very densely tufted sedge from New Zealand. Unusual dull brown hair-like leaves. Flowers June-August. Height 45 cm. Best grown in a damp to wet soil in a sheltered position.	2 lit.
CAREG	<b>Carex oshimensis 'Evergold'</b>	An attractive sedge forming compact tufts with arching leaves with broad creamy yellow stripe. Height 30 cm. Best grown in a damp to wet soil in a sheltered position. RHS 'Award of Garden Merit'.	2 lit.
CARFC	<b>Carex comans 'Frosted Curls'</b>	From New Zealand. Forms a compact silver-green "haystack" with brown seed heads. Height 20cm. Requires sun or light shade and moist acid soil.	2 lit.

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CARFLAG	<b>Carex flagellifera</b>	New Zealand sedge with upright long stems and coarse leaves of pale bronze to tawny brown. Forms low arching dome of dense tufts. Height 50-70cm. Prefers damp to wet soil.	2 lit.
CARIB	<b>Carex 'Island Brocade'</b>	Variegated sedge from Japan. Vigorous habit with strong golden edges. Ideal for containers. Height 20cm. Best grown in a damp to wet soil in full sun or partial shade.	2 lit.
CARID	<b>Carex 'Ice Dance'</b>	An attractive sedge forming tufts with arching white variegated leaves. Produces slowly spreading runners. Height 40 cm. Best grown in a damp to wet soil in full sun or partial shade.	2 lit.
CARKAG	<b>Carex dolichostachya 'Kaga-nishiki'</b>	An attractive sedge forming compact tufts with arching leaves. Pale green leaves that are variegated golden yellow. Height 25cm. Best grown in a damp to wet soil.	2 lit.
CARMFF	<b>Carex morrowii 'Fishers Form'</b>	An attractive sedge forming compact tufts with arching leaves. Large cream variegated leaves. Height 50 cm. Best grown in a damp to wet soil in a sheltered position.	2 lit.
CARMLM	<b>Carex muskingumensis 'Little Midge'</b>	'Dwarf Palm Sedge' Evergreen, tuft-forming graceful perennial sedge with narrow green leaves. Brown flowers in summer. Height 25cm. Spread 20cm. Best plants in groups. Prefers damp site. Will grow in full sun or light shade.	2 lit.
CARMOO	<b>Carex pendula 'Moonraker'</b>	Evergreen, tuft-forming graceful perennial sedge with pale, creamy white spring foliage, greenish brown flower spikes in summer. Height 120cm. Spread 50cm. Requires partial shade and moist soil.	2 lit.
CARMUS	<b>Carex muskingumensis</b>	"Palm Sedge" Evergreen, tuft-forming graceful perennial sedge with narrow green leaves. Attractive flowers in summer. Prefers damp site. Height 50 - 60cm	2 lit.
CARPEN	<b>Carex pendula</b>	"Weeping Sedge" Evergreen, tuft-forming graceful perennial sedge with narrow green leaves, 45cm long. Solid, triangular stems freely produce pendant, greenish brown flower spikes in summer. Height 1m. Spread 30cm. Requires partial shade and well drained soil.	2 lit.
CARSIST	<b>Carex 'Silver Streams'</b>	Clump forming sedge with bright silver and green leaves. Height 20cm. Will grow in sun or partial shade, prefers moist soil. Ideal for containers.	2 lit.
CARTEN	<b>Carex tenuiculmis</b>	Upright clump forming sedge from New Zealand. Arching light brown leaves. Flower spikes in May. Height up to 45cm. Best grown in sunny position.	2 lit.
DESCBH	<b>Deschampsia cespitosa 'Goldgehänge' (Golden Pendant)</b>	Arching tussocks of shining dark green leaves. Large panicles tinted gold produced from June to August, that last into the winter. Height 120 cm. Grows best in moist semi-shade ideal in woodland setting.	2 lit.
DESCBV	<b>Deschampsia c. 'Bronze Veil' ('Bronzeschleier')</b>	"Tufted Hair Grass" Arching tussocks of shining dark green leaves. Large panicles tinted bronze produced from June to August, that last into the winter. Height 100 cm. Grows best in moist semi-shade ideal in woodland setting.	2 lit.
DESCES	<b>Deschampsia cespitosa</b>	"Tufted Hairy Grass" Attractive 'mop head' clumps of shining dark. Large, fine hair-like panicles from June to August, that last into the winter. Height 90 cm. Grows best in moist semi-shade ideal in woodland setting.	2 lit.
DESCGD	<b>Deschampsia c. 'Golden Dew' ('Goldtau')</b>	"Tufted Hair Grass" Compact tussocks dark green leaves. Graceful panicles turning golden yellow in Autumn. Height 80 cm. Grows best in moist soil in full sun.	2 lit.
DESCPF	<b>Deschampsia cespitosa 'Pixie Fountain'</b>	"Tufted Hair Grass" Compact tussocks dark green leaves. Silver-green panicles turning golden yellow in Autumn. Height 60 cm. Grows best in moist soil in full sun.	2 lit.
DESFTG	<b>Deschampsia flexuosa 'Tatra Gold'</b>	Attractive tuft forming, perennial grass. Fully hardy. Has dense, narrow, bright lime-green arching leaves. In summer produces dainty, open panicles of minute, green-purple spikelets that last well into winter. Height 30 cm. Requires sun and shade and drained soil.	2 lit.

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DESSCH	<b>Deschampsia cespitosa 'Schottland'</b>	"Tufted Hair Grass" Compact tussocks dark green leaves. Graceful bronze panicles turning golden yellow in Autumn. Height 90 cm. Grows best in moist soil, in full sun.	2 lit.
ERAELL	<b>Eragrostis eliottii</b>	'Blue Love Grass' Clump forming perennial grass. Blue-green nodding flowers in summer. Height 70cm. Best grown in full sun.	2 lit.
FESGBF	<b>Festuca glauca 'Blue Fox' ('Blaufuchs')</b>	Evergreen, tuft forming perennial grass. Fully hardy. Has narrow grey-blue leaves. Bears panicles of spikelets in summer. Divide every 2-3 years in spring. Height 15cm. Requires sun. RHS 'Award of Garden Merit'	2 lit.
FESGEB	<b>Festuca glauca 'Elijah Blue'</b>	Evergreen, tuft forming. Fully hardy. Has narrow blue-grey leaves. Bears panicles of spikelets in summer. Divide every 2-3 years in spring. Height 15cm. Requires sun or light shade. Best planted in groups.	2 lit.
FESGGT	<b>Festuca glauca 'Golden Toupee'</b>	Evergreen, tuft forming. Fully hardy. Has narrow golden yellow leaves. Bears panicles of spikelets in summer. Divide every 2-3 years in spring. Height 25cm. Requires sun or light shade. Best planted in groups.	2 lit.
FESGLA	<b>Festuca glauca</b>	"Blue Fescue" Evergreen, tuft forming. Fully hardy. Has narrow leaves in various shades of blue-green to silvery white. Bears panicles of spikelets in summer. Divide every 2-3 years in spring. Height 10cm. Requires sun.	2 lit.
FESGMIN	<b>Festuca glauca minima</b>	A very dwarf form of Festuca glauca, evergreen, with fine blue-grey leaves, neat habit. Height 10 cm. Prefers full sun.	2 lit.
FESGSB	<b>Festuca 'Siskyou Blue'</b>	Evergreen, tuft forming. Fully hardy. Has narrow bristly blue-grey leaves in various shades of blue-grey. Bears panicles of spikelets in summer. Divide every 2-3 years in spring. Trim in early spring or mid-summer to encourage new growth. Height 25cm. Requires sun.	2 lit.
FESSIL	<b>Festuca glauca 'Silberreiher'</b>	Evergreen, tuft forming. Fully hardy. Has narrow silvery-blue leaves. Bears panicles of spikelets in summer. Divide every 2-3 years in spring. Height 15cm. Best grown in full sun and well drained soil.	2 lit.
FESUCH	<b>Festuca glauca 'Uchte'</b>	Evergreen, tuft forming, hardy grass with blue-green leaves. Bears tawny spikelets in May to June. Divide every 2-3 years in spring. Height 30cm. Best grown in full and well drained soil.	2 lit.
FESVGLA	<b>Festuca valesiaca var. glauantha</b>	"Wallis Fescue" Evergreen, tuft forming. Fully hardy. Has fine blue-green hair-like leaves. Bears panicles of spikelets in May to June. Divide every 2-3 years in spring. Height 25cm. Requires sun.	2 lit.
GLYMPVAR	<b>Glyceria maxima 'Variegata'</b>	Herbaceous, spreading, perennial grass with cream striped leaves, often tinged pink at the base. Bears open panicles of greenish spikelets in summer. Height 80cm. Spread indefinite. Requires full sun and moist soil.	2 lit.
HAKMAUR	<b>Hakonechloa macra 'Aureola'</b>	Slow growing, rhizomatous grass, with purple stems and green striped, yellow leaves that age to reddish brown. Open panicles of reddish brown flower spikes may appear in autumn and last into winter. Height 45cm. Requires full sun and well drained soil. RHS 'Award of Garden Merit'	2 lit.
HELSAP	<b>Helictotrichon sempervirens 'Saphirsprudel'</b>	"Blue Oat-grass" Evergreen, tufted, perennial grass with upright silvery-blue leaves up to 30cm or more long. Produces erect panicles of straw coloured flower spikes in summer. erect panicles of straw coloured flower spikes in summer. Height 1 metre. Spread 60 cm. Requires full sun and well drained soil.	2 lit.
HELSEM	<b>Helictotrichon sempervirens (syn. Avena candida)</b>	"Blue Oat-grass" Evergreen, tufted, perennial grass with stiff silvery-blue leaves up to 30cm or more long. Produces erect panicles of straw coloured flower spikes in summer. Height 1 metre. Spread 60 cm. Requires full sun and well drained soil. RHS 'Award of Garden Merit'.	2 lit.
IMPRB	<b>Imperata cylindrica 'Rubra'</b>	"Blood Grass". Long narrow reddish foliage turning bright crimson through Summer with contrasting silvery-white flowers. Height 60cm Spread 30cm. Plant in sun or light shade in moist soil.	2 lit.
JUNSPI	<b>Juncus filiformis 'Spiralis'</b>	Evergreen, tuft forming, perennial rush with dark green leafless stems that twist and curl and are often prostrate. Fairly dense, greenish-brown flower panicles form in summer. Height 20 cm. Requires full sun and moist soil.	2 lit.

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KOEGLA	<b>Koeleria glauca</b>	"Blue Hair Grass". Dense clumps of narrow blue leaves. Height 25cm. Best in a sunny situation.	2 lit.
LEYARE	<b>Leymus arenarius (syn. Elymus arenarius)</b>	"Blue Lyme Grass" Tuft forming grasses with distinctive blue-grey foliage. Upright habit, slowing spreading. Buff blue flowers from June to August. Height 60cm. Sunny position.	2 lit.
LUZAUR	<b>Luzula sylvatica 'Aurea'</b>	Evergreen, slow-spreading, perennial rush with fairly dense clusters of chestnut flower spikes in early summer. Leaves are yellow and lined with white hairs. Height 45cm, spread 30cm. Requires partial shade and well drained soil.	2 lit.
LUZHT	<b>Luzula sylvatica 'Hohe Tatra'</b>	"Greater Wood-rush" Evergreen, slow-spreading, perennial rush with fairly dense clusters of brown flower spikes in early summer. Leaves are yellow - green and lined with white hairs. Height 30cm, spread 30 cm. Requires partial shade and well drained soil.	2 lit.
LUZNIV	<b>Luzula nivea</b>	"Snowy Wood-rush" Evergreen, slow-spreading, perennial rush with fairly dense clusters of shining, white flower spikes in early summer. Leaves are edged with white hairs. Height 60cm. Requires partial shade.	2 lit.
LUZSMAR	<b>Luzula sylvatica 'Marginata'</b>	"Greater Wood-rush" Evergreen, slow-spreading, perennial rush with fairly dense clusters of brown flower spikes in early summer. Leaves are mid-green with white margins and lined with white hairs. Height 30cm, spread 30 cm. Best in partial shade.	2 lit.
LUZSYL	<b>Luzula sylvatica</b>	"Greater Wood-rush" Evergreen, slow-spreading, perennial rush with fairly dense clusters of brown flower spikes in early summer. Leaves are dark green and lined with white hairs. Height 30cm, spread 30 cm. Requires partial shade and well drained soil.	2 lit.
LUZTC	<b>Luzula sylvatica 'Taggart's Cream'</b>	Evergreen, slow-spreading, perennial rush with fairly dense clusters of brown flower spikes in early summer. New leaves are white in spring and age to cream, turning green later and lined with white hairs. Height 45cm, spread 30 cm. Best grown in partial shade.	2 lit.
MELUVAR	<b>Melica uniflora 'Variegata'</b>	"Wood Melic". Loosely tufted perennial grass with striped green and white leaves. Flower heads produced from May to June. Height 50 cm. Requires shade and good soil.	2 lit.
MILAUAR	<b>Millium effusum 'Aureum'</b>	"Bowles's Golden Grass" Erect tufts of bright lemon yellow leaves. Ideal for lighting up shaded areas. Light airy flower heads. 40cm. Prefers moist semi-shade. RHS 'Award of Garden Merit'.	2 lit.
MILYAF	<b>Millium effusum 'Yaffle'</b>	Erect tufts of bright pale green leaves with yellow central stripe. Ideal for lighting up shaded areas. Light airy yellow flower heads. Self seeds. Height 40cm. Spread 30cm. Prefers moist semi-shade.	2 lit.
MISCOS	<b>Miscanthus sinensis var. condensatus 'Cosmopolitan'</b>	Herbaceous, perennial grass, forming dense clumps with distinctive golden variegated leaves, feathery spikelets in late summer. Height 300cm. Requires full sun and well drained soil. RHS 'Award of Garden Merit'	3 lit.
MISFO	<b>Miscanthus sinensis 'Ferne Osten'</b>	Herbaceous, clump forming, perennial grass with compact habit. Narrow leaves with silver midrib. Reddish flowers in autumn. Height 120cm. Spread 45cm. Requires full sun and well drained soil.	2 lit.
MISGB	<b>Miscanthus sinensis 'Gold Bar'</b>	Herbaceous, clump-forming, perennial grass. Compact, upright habit. Leaves have transverse, cream-yellow markings. Carries white flower heads in autumn, that last overwinter. Height 60cm. Requires full sun and well drained soil. Plant Breeder Rights Apply, (Propagation prohibited).	2 lit.
MISGF	<b>Miscanthus sinensis 'Grosse Fontäne'</b>	Herbaceous, clump forming, perennial grass, with narrow leaves. Silver inflorescence during July and August which retain interest during Winter. Height 180cm. Requires full sun and well drained soil. RHS 'Award of Garden Merit'	2 lit.
MISGIF	<b>Miscanthus sinensis 'Giraffe'</b>	Herbaceous, clump-forming, perennial grass. Fine gold banded leaves, hairy spikelets in fan-shaped panicles in autumn. Height 200cm. Spread 45cm. Requires full sun and well drained soil.	3 lit.
MISGIG	<b>Miscanthus x giganteus</b>	Large herbeous, clump forming perennial grass, with dark green leaves. Silky purple tinted inflorescence during late summer. Height 300cm. Requires full sun and well drained soil.	3 lit.

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MISGRAC	<b>Miscanthus sinensis 'Gracillimus'</b>	Herbaceous, clump forming, perennial grass, with narrow green leaves. Pink flowers in late summer, that turn silver in autumn. Height 120cm. Spread 100cm. Requires full sun and well drained soil.	2 lit.
MISKAS	<b>Miscanthus sinensis 'Kascade'</b>	Herbaceous, clump forming, perennial grass, feathery pinkish spikelets in August to October. Height 120-150cm. Requires full sun and well drained soil. RHS 'Award of Garden Merit'	3 lit.
MISKS	<b>Miscanthus sinensis 'Kleine Silberspinne'</b>	Compact habit. Herbaceous, clump forming, perennial grass, with narrow leaves, open spidery flower head, reddish turning silver in late autumn. Height 90cm. Requires full sun and well drained soil. RHS 'Award of Garden Merit'	2 lit.
MISMAL	<b>Miscanthus sinensis 'Malepartus'</b>	Herbaceous, clump forming, perennial grass, with narrow leaves, hairy beneath often turning bronze. May bear fan shaped panicles of awned, deep red spikelets in early autumn. Height 225cm. Spread 45cm. Requires full sun and well drained soil.	3 lit.
MISML	<b>Miscanthus sinensis 'Morning Light'</b>	Herbaceous, clump forming, perennial grass, with attractive narrow variegated leaves, feathery white spikelets in late summer. Height 150cm. Requires full sun and well drained soil. RHS 'Award of Garden Merit'	2 lit.
MISPUN	<b>Miscanthus sinensis 'Pünkchen'</b>	Herbaceous, clump-forming, perennial grass. Leaves, hairy beneath, have transverse, gold ring markings. May carry awned, hairy white spikelets in fan-shaped panicles in autumn. Height 150cm Spread 45cm. Requires full sun and well drained soil.	2 lit.
MISROT	<b>Miscanthus sinensis 'Rotsilber'</b>	Herbaceous, clump forming, perennial grass, with silvery stripe down the centre of leaf. Red flowers in late summer, that turn silver in autumn. Height 150cm. Spread 100cm. Requires full sun and well drained soil.	2 lit.
MISSTR	<b>Miscanthus sinensis 'Strictus'</b>	Herbaceous, clump-forming, perennial grass. Upright habit. Leaves have transverse, yellowish-white markings. Carries white flower heads in autumn, that last overwinter. Height 150cm. Improved hardiness. Requires full sun and well drained soil. RHS 'Award of Garden Merit'	2 lit.
MISTRA	<b>Miscanthus transmorrisonensis</b>	Clump forming, semi-evergreen perennial grass with arching green leaves. Flower spikes of attractive white plumes in late summer and autumn. Height 120cm. Prefers full sun and well drained soil.	2 lit.
MISVAR	<b>Miscanthus sinensis 'Variegatus'</b>	Herbaceous, clump forming, perennial grass, with attractive narrow green and yellow variegated leaves, feathery white spikelets in late summer. Height 180cm. Requires full sun and well drained soil.	3 lit.
MISYAK	<b>Miscanthus sinensis 'Yakushima Dwarf'</b>	Very compact habit. Herbaceous, clump forming, perennial grass, with narrow leaves, pale pinkish-brown feathery spikelets in late summer age to white in winter. Height 60-90cm. Requires full sun and well drained soil.	2 lit.
MISZEB	<b>Miscanthus sinensis 'Zebrinus'</b>	Herbaceous, clump-forming, perennial grass. Leaves, hairy beneath, have transverse, yellowish-white ring markings. May carry awned, hairy white spikelets in fan-shaped panicles in autumn. Height 1.2m. Spread 45cm. Requires full sun and well drained soil. RHS 'Award of Garden Merit'	2 lit.
MOLARU	<b>Molinia caerulea subsp. arundinacea</b>	"Purple Moor Grass" Attractive tuft forming grass, herbaceous, fully hardy. Produces spreading panicles of purple spiklets on erect stems. July to October. Height 175 cm. Needs a dry, sunny position and acid soil.	2 lit.
MOLCAR	<b>Molinia caerulea subsp. c. 'Carmarthen'</b>	Attractive tuft forming grass with creamy yellow striped leaves, herbaceous, fully hardy. Produces spreading panicles of brown spiklets on erect stems from July to October. Height 45 cm. Needs a dry, sunny position and acid soil.	2 lit.
MOLCVAR	<b>Molinia caerulea subsp. c. 'Variegata'</b>	Attractive tuft forming grass with white striped leaves, herbaceous, fully hardy. Produces spreading panicles of purple spiklets on erect stems from July to October. Height 35 cm. Needs a dry, sunny position and acid soil. RHS 'Award of Garden Merit'.	2 lit.
MOLED	<b>Molinia caerulea subsp. c. 'Edith Dudszus'</b>	"Purple Moor Grass" Attractive tuft forming grass, herbaceous, fully hardy. Produces spreading panicles of dark spiklets on erect stems from July to October. Height 60 cm. Needs a dry, sunny position and acid soil.	2 lit.
MOLHEI	<b>Molinia caerulea subsp. c. 'Heidebraut'</b>	Tuft forming grass with upright foliage, Soft straw yellow flowers in July to September. Height 150cm. Grows best on damp acid soil.	2 lit.

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MOLKF	<b>Molinia caerulea subsp. arundinacea 'Karl Foerster'</b>	"Purple Moor Grass" Attractive tuft forming grass, herbaceous, fully hardy. Produces spreading panicles of dark spiklets on erect stems from July to October. Height 150 cm. Needs a dry, sunny position and acid soil.	2 lit.
